### 5. WORK PLAN AND POTENTIAL INITIATIVES

Potential items for working group action:

• Conversions of single family homes

- What are the rules around rooming houses and why can a property operate so closely to a rooming house model?
- Work on engaging the university in constructing additional residences
- Work on an off-campus code of conduct
- Education of new tenants on their rights and their responsibilities
- Work to engage absentee and problematic landlords; possibly start a landlord school, such as the one which existed in Hintonburg
- Density of the student housing is also an issue as it is easy to lose an entire block to problem addresses.
- Derelict properties (whether they be private or university-owned)
